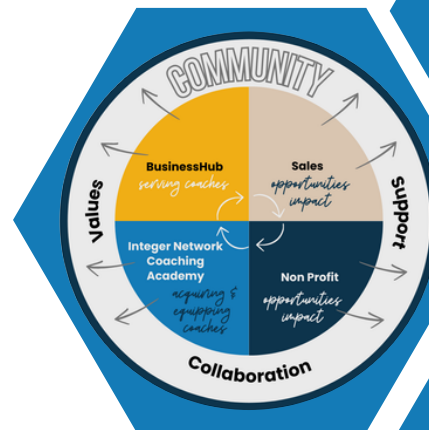

Thank you for being on this journey with us.

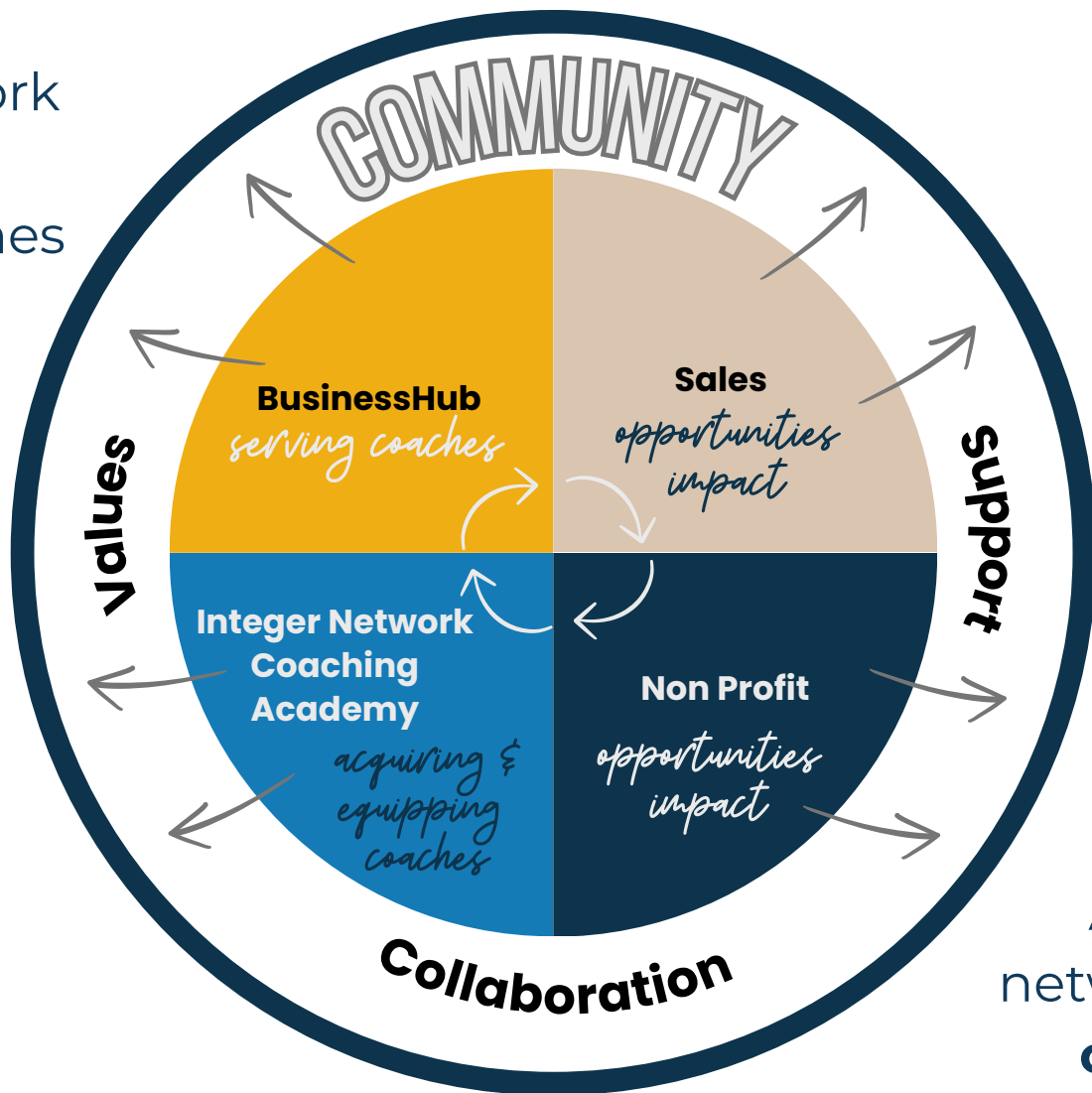

EMPOWERING COACHES TO BUILD THEIR DREAM

At the core, the Business Hub is about taking care of all the behind the scenes work so that coaches can coach! We have worked hard this year to create systems and services that support our members as people, practitioners and professionals. Through being strategic thinking partners, logo designers, invoice senders and webinar facilitators (to mention a few things) we are creating a foundation for our coaches to build from.



INTEGER NETWORK COMMUNITY

A SPACE TO BE, TO BELONG, TO BE CHALLENGED

While coaching is the modality we have chosen to champion, we know that many people share our values and heart for impact. The Integer Network Community grew from an abstract idea to a 53 member strong community of coaches, friends, counselors, family and individuals who meet to practice the values of authenticity, connection and wholeness. This has become a place for discussions, belonging and curiosity.

INCA

QUALITY COACH TRAINING MADE ACCESSIBLE

High quality coaching certifications are very expensive. We believe that the modality of coaching should be much more accessible for everyone across the globe. So this year, in partnership with Fletcher Seminary, we established the Integer Network Coaching Academy and our incredible faculty of coaches have developed the curriculum and are in the process of guiding 11 students from 4 different countries through our first official cohort. We are also in the process of applying for our International Coaching Federation Level 1 Accreditation.



NPO IMPACT AND GROWTH

IMPACT WHERE IT MATTERS MOST

In the Non Profit space we have worked hard to establish ourselves as a trusted source of high quality coaching for NPO leaders and their teams. A lot of this has involved speaking engagements in which we could educate around the power of coaching to protect your fire and prevent burnout. We also participated in the Wellness Collab hosted by Nation Builder and was a leading voice in advocating for coaching as a built in care model for non profit organizations. Since then, ED Jana Belter, has been asked to serve on the steering committee for the Network Leaders Community of Practice, a network of NPO Network Leaders.





Impact and Outcomes

Impact

- **Belonging and Connection:** Coaches who once felt isolated reported a renewed sense of community. Several shared that our peer groups became their “safe space” for reflection and growth.
- **Professional Growth:** INCA graduates are now actively coaching in their local contexts – launching practices, serving nonprofits, and mentoring others. A number of these coaches are working in East Africa, broadening our geographic footprint.
- **Sustainable Coaching Practices:** Through the Business Hub, coaches established more stable practices, with increased recurring clients and peer collaborations – reducing the burden of solo entrepreneurship.
- **Organizational Resilience:** Nonprofit teams we coached reported reduced burnout, improved team cohesion, and renewed clarity of purpose. Leaders spoke of deeper alignment between their values and their work.
- **Strategic Alignment:** Every program, event, and engagement clearly aligned with our strategic goals – to expand our global community, deepen relational coaching, and enhance access to high-quality coaching in the nonprofit sector.

Outcomes

Thanks to these inputs, we were able to deliver:

- **Community Engagement:** Monthly gatherings, mentor meet-ups, and themed conversations that deepened relational trust and peer learning.
- **Training & Certification:** INCA, our Coaching Academy, launched new cohorts of values-driven coaches, grounded in globally applicable frameworks as well as a graduate certificate in Compassionate Conversations.
- **Business Support:** Through the Business Hub, coaches received guidance on building sustainable coaching practices – including administrative infrastructure, client acquisition, and collaboration opportunities.
- **Direct Coaching Services:** We facilitated coaching engagements with nonprofit teams and helping professionals, focusing on reducing burnout, boosting resilience, and enhancing leadership capacity.
- **Events & Thought Leadership:** We hosted workshops, webinars, and events that stimulated reflection, self-awareness, and systemic change.
